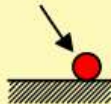
My Turn for a Test



I will go to the test room.



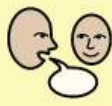
I wash and dry my hands.



In the test room, there will be adults.



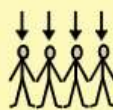
I can ask adults for help. I can ask questions.

The adults will have face masks. The adults wear






face masks to help keep everyone safe.

 I rub the swab  four times  on each  side.

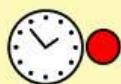
 I take the swab out of my  mouth and do not touch my 

 teeth or  tongue with the  swab.

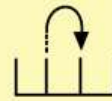
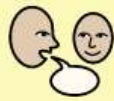
 An adult tells me how to  put the swab inside my 

 nose. The swab tickles. It will finish  fast

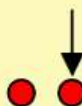
Then I am finished. I can feel proud.  



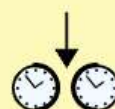
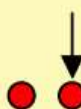
After my test



After my test, an adult says what happens next.



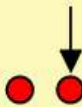
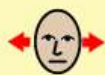
I might need a second test.



If I need a second test, it will be soon. It might be



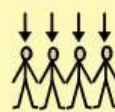
in school or at a special test centre.
