

# ICT

## Subject Overview



**Using Interfaces** Students will learn to utilise interfaces on numerous devices to help them be productive and access information. They will develop skills in accessing desktop computers, touchscreen devices and voice recognition software to enhance accessibility to our curriculum.

**Digital Literacy** Students develop skills which allow them to access digital information and make sense of this allowing them to utilise and make decisions based upon this. They explore creating original digital content through a variety of platforms and mediums to communicate ideas and express themselves.



**Content Creation** Students access a range of programs and resources to develop and enhance their creativity skills and allow them to express themselves. Different mediums such as text, imagery, video, music and audio can be created, edited and combined to convey ideas and concepts to different target audiences

**eSafety** Students learn how to stay safe whilst using the internet by being aware of the potential risks posed by interacting and communicating on digital platforms and social media covering concepts such as cyberbullying, grooming, digital footprint and online etiquette.



**Research** Students learn how to utilise the internet to find, access and discover information to allow them to make informed decisions and broaden their understanding of the world around them.
