Highfield is Expanding!

We are delighted to share that Highfield School is expanding.

Earlier this year the Local Authority invited us to expand our provision.

To enable us to provide for more pupils the Futures Pathway of Post 16 are moving to Thornes Park to take up residence in a newly refurbished floor of the building.

It has been an exciting few months as the area is being remodelled to ensure students have cooking facilities for shop, cook, eat sessions; access to outdoor space, a sensory room and ICT space.

This means that from September Post 16 will be across 3 sites. The Moving On Pathway remains at the main site for this year and we also have City Futures based in Wakefield Town Centre.

City Futures opened last September and has had a very successful first year.

This means that we will be welcoming more Year 7 students than previous years and our SCERTS pathway will be growing from 1 to 3 classes.

We are very pleased to be welcoming new teachers to school who we have introduced below.


You will also receive a covering letter for yourselves with these details on.

Uniform and PE Kit—Years 7-11

Please see below details of school uniform.

Please ensure all uniform is labelled including jackets and coats.

From this September we are requesting students wear black or grey bottoms (shorts, leggings or joggers) with a white t-shirt.

Please contact school if you have any questions regarding this.

Students should bring their labelled PE kit in a bag on their PE or Fitness days.

Uniform

All pupils are required to wear school uniform.

This is: grey or black school trousers or skirts, purple or white polo shirt or white school shirt, navy blue jumper and black shoes.

If a pupil has an identified sensory need then they may wear plain black or blue jogging bottoms with prior agreement with the school.

Students must wear trousers instead of leggings as they are more appropriate for school.

Uniform with the school logo on can be purchased from The Box in Ossett. Please see the leaflet which is included in your welcome pack.

You can also purchase school uniform and shoes in these colours from major supermarkets and High Street shops.



PE Kit

Black or grey shorts / Jogging bottoms or leggings, white t-shirt, trainers & change of socks.

You will be made aware of the days that your child requires PE kit before they start in September.

During the Summer holidays the class dojo system will be temporarily suspended but we will leave Parent Support Advisors connected should you need to contact school in an emergency.

New classes will be set up over the summer and your new teacher will be reconnected for Monday the 4th of September.

On the training days, staff time is timetabled for training and meetings so please do contact Admin if you are wanting a quick reply.



If you require more details regarding joining class dojo please ring school and Admin will be able to help you.

We highly recommend it so you can keep updated on what is happening in school and stay in contact with your child's teacher.

Final Weeks of Term

The final week of term will be very busy.

For Year 11 and Year 14 students their final day is Friday the 14th of July.

Those students attending Highfield Post 16 then return on Monday the 17th, Tuesday the 18th and Wednesday the 19th for formal transition days.

They no longer need to wear school uniform.



Students in Years 7-10 will have their transition days on Monday the 17th and Wednesday the 19th of July. (They still are required to wear school uniform)

Then Friday the 21st of July is party day across school! Students can attend in non-uniform.

There will be class parties in the morning and a disco in the afternoon.
